With 4 acres of planted vines on Manor Lane in Jamesport, Diliberto Winery is certainly one of the smallest wineries on the East End of Long Island. Nevertheless, their initial entry into the world of wine competition met with startling success: the three wines they submitted to the New York Wine & Food Classic in August 2004 were each awarded a Gold Medal. This amazing result was improved upon in 2005 when their 2003 Merlot was named "Best Merlot" at the New York Wine & Food Classic. Both Sal and Maryann Diliberto, co-owners of the winery, have a passion for wine and the role that it can play in life. Their new tasting room, which opened in June 2007, reflects not only their passion for the enjoyment of wine, but a deep pride in their Italian heritage. Tasting room guests are served their tastings at bistro tables and can enjoy the interior "piazza" the Dilibertos have created, or they can sit on the patio and get pleasure from the views of the perfectly manicured vineyard.
