Sherwood House wines are handcrafted using traditional methods combined with the latest scientific techniques. Gently pressed from handpicked grapes, the juices are fermented and aged in French oak barrels for extended periods of time. All the grapes used for these limited-release wines are grown on the vineyard estate, located in Mattituck on the North Fork of Long Island.

The premium wines of Sherwood House are produced in limited quantities and are featured at some of the finest restaurants and wine retailers in New York. Sherwood House has a tasting room, open to the public.
