Dedicated to the enjoyment of wine as an everyday sensory pleasure, Bouké is the brainchild of Lisa Donneson, a Long Island native with a Diploma in Wines and Spirits from the Wine and Spirit Education Trust (WSET). Donneson developed Bouké with Gilles Martin, the award-winning winemaker known for his work as a consultant to wineries including Roederer, Delas-Frères, and Sherwood House.

Not trophy wines to save for "someday," these delicious, food-friendly blends are ready to drink now and represent excellent value. Bouké's boldly striped labels are as fun and fresh as its eccentric spelling of the traditional wine term bouquet.
