



Background

In 2000, the partners of Clovis Point purchased 10 acres of farmland in Jamesport, with the dream of creating a top flight vineyard and boutique winery that would showcase the finest wines from the North Fork. In 2002, the partners acquired an additional vineyard nearby, which was already planted with some of the oldest vines on Long Island. In July 2007, Clovis Point renovated and opened its elegant yet rustic tasting room, a converted 1920s potato barn. Since then, the wines and tasting room have obtained critical acclaim.

In the vineyard, Clovis Point keeps the grape yield down with significant fruit thinning to insure concentrated fruit. In the winery, Clovis Point blends different lots of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Petit Verdot to make distinctive red wines with character and balance. Its tank-fermented Chardonnay is crisp and clean, while the barrel-fermented Chardonnay is full-bodied and complex. Its Merlot is round and juicy on the palate and its Vintner's Select Merlot is smooth, elegant and full bodied. With winemaker John Leo, vineyard consultant Peter Gristina, and general manager Carmela Paciullo, Clovis Point is already producing award-winning wines.
